

How will you prevent infection spreading?

Handwashing

All staff, children and visitors will be expected to wash their hands with antibacterial soap and water when they arrive in the building. There will also be alcohol based hand gel in all classrooms and at the main entrance.

Children and staff will wash their hands before and after playtime and lunchtime.

Limiting equipment from home

Children should only bring their book bag, coat and packed lunch (if they need one). No other bags should be brought from home. All children are provided with a PE kit that will remain in school and should not be taken home. Please do not send any other PE kit into school.

Catch it, bin it, kill it

There is a supply of tissues in every classroom. Children will be reminded that they should cough or sneeze into a tissue that is then put into a bin with a lid that is emptied regularly

Increased cleaning / sanitising

We will continue with our cleaning regime - classroom staff will clean equipment and tables throughout the day. Every night the cleaning team will thoroughly clean the whole school building.

Sharing equipment

Children from Year 1 to Year 6 will have their own pencil case of equipment so that they do not share pencils etc. All shared toys and equipment will be sanitised regularly throughout the day.
