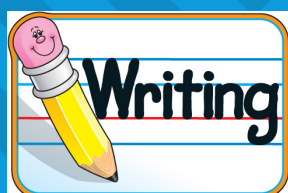


English - Spring 1

Early Years



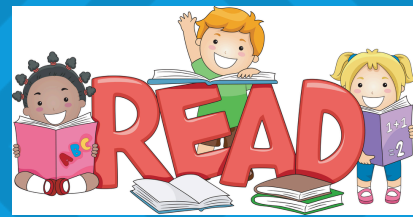
Nursery's project is Let's Explore. They will be reading the following book titles, 'The Great Explorer', 'Real Life Explorers', 'Lost and Found' and 'The Big Adventure'. They will also be reading stories written by our focus author, Jill Murphy. The children will be developing their small muscle coordination to support their pencil control.

Reception will be reading books by Eric Carle. The theme is 'Ready, Steady Grow' and some of book titles include, Farmer Duck, Jasper's Beanstalk, Oliver's Vegetables and Machines on the Farm. This will support the children to develop independence in writing simple sentences ensuring they are using a capital letter, fingers spaces and a full stop. They will also experience writing labels for drawings.

Key Stage 1

Year 1 are reading 'Arlo' by Catherine Rayner. They'll be writing a similar story and writing a report.

Year 2 are reading 'The Giant Jam Sandwich' by John Vernon Lord. They will be retelling the story and writing instructions on how to make a giant jam sandwich.



Lower Key Stage 2



Year 3 are reading 'The Queen Of Darkness' by Tony Bradman. They will then write a similar narrative story and a non-chronological report.

Year 4 are reading 'Tyger' by SF Said. They will then write a story in the same style with and some explanation writing.

Upper Key Stage 2

Year 5 are reading 'Diver's Daughter' by Patrice Lawrence. They will then write a story in the same style as the author and a persuasive text.

Year 6 are reading 'Windrush Child' by Benjamin Zaphaniah. They will then write a story similar story focusing on dialogue and a journalistic recount.
