<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>The children will be following their tailored Read Write Inc plan. Once they have progressed through all of the books, grey being the last colour they will be taught English.</p>	<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>The children will read a book about feelings called 'In My Heart' by Joe Witek and write some instructions about how to make their happy heart giggle and wiggle. They'll then read an exciting story by Colin McNaughton named 'Once Upon an Ordinary School Day' and write their own story about an exciting imaginary day at school.</p>	<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>The children will read an adventure book called 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman. They will be doing lots of short writes including letters, setting descriptions and dialogues between characters. They will be re-telling their own version of a part of the story to show how much they have learned. We are hoping that they add inverted commas in any speech they write. The second big write will be from one of the characters to the king to ask him to release her father from prison. There are lots of opportunities to practise their persuasive writing.</p>	<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>The children will read the novel 'The Boy At The Back Of The Class' by Oryali Q Rauf and write from the point of view of the character in different ways. They'll write a story from the point of view of a refugee child and also write explanation texts based on refugees.</p>	<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>The children will read a book called 'Diver's Daughter' by Patrice Lawrence which links to our project Tudors. The children will write a narrative story about the incident the main character Eve is involved in. They will then plan and write a non-chronological report all about Henry VIII homes.</p>	<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>The children will read an adventure story called 'Brightstorm' by Vashti Hardy and they'll be writing their own newspaper reports as well as their own part of the story.</p>
	<p><u>Spring 2</u></p> <p>The children will read 'George And The Dragon' by Christopher Wormell. They'll write a story about the book and write a letter from the mouse to the dragon to persuade them to be friends.</p>	<p><u>Spring 2</u></p> <p>We will be reading 'Theseus and the Minotaur' by Hugh Lupton. For this book we will be writing lots of little writes such as character descriptions, letters and explanations. Our independent writing will involve writing a 5-part story and a set of instructions about how to escape the labyrinth.</p>	<p><u>Spring 2</u></p> <p>The children will read 'Alone On A Wide, Wide Sea' by Michael Morpurgo. They'll write a story influenced by the book and think about the atmosphere and mood when writing their narrative.</p>	<p><u>Spring 2</u></p> <p>The children will read a book called 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. They will plan and retell the story from the point of view of a different character. They will then write a set of instructions linked to our Design and Technology about pulleys and leavers.</p>	<p><u>Spring 2</u></p> <p>The children will read 'Rose Blanche', a picture book based in WW2, by Ian McEwan. The children will be writing from two different perspectives. They will also write an explanation text about the war for example evacuation and rationing.</p>
