Early Years



 Nursery are reading Traditional Tales and stories written by Nick Butterworth. They will be starting Read, Write Inc phonics and learning to write single letters and names.
 Reception are reading lots of non-fiction texts to help them learn about life cycles. They will be writing instructions, labels and captions to support our understanding.

Key Stage 1

Year 1 are reading 'The Owl Who Was Afraid Of The Dark' by Jill Tomlinson. They will then write a similar narrative story and some instructions.

Year 2 are reading 'The Day The Ocean Went Away' by Sam Haynes. They will then be writing a similar narrative story and some persuasive writing about plastic pollution.



Lower Key Stage 2



Year 3 are reading 'Anglo Saxon Boy' by Tony Bradman. They will then write a similar story in paragraphs with a problem and resolution. They will also write a set of instructions.

Year 4 are reading 'Rooftops' by Katherine Rundell. They will then write a narrative in role as a character from the book and a recount.

Upper Key Stage 2

Year 5 are reading 'The Night Bus Hero' by Onjali Q. Rauf.
They will then plan a non-linear story with flashbacks and a balanced discussion presenting two sides of an argument.
Year 6 are reading 'Boy Overboard' by Morris Gleitzman.
They will be retelling a similar story in chapters and an explanation text.
